About the College

In 1965, President G. Homer Durham hired Willard H. Pedrick to become Arizona State University's first law school dean and tasked him with the responsibility of building, literally from the ground up, its very first law school. Located on ASU's Tempe campus, Armstrong Hall housed the law school until its move to the downtown Phoenix campus in 2016.

In 1970, the first class of 83 students graduated with their Juris Doctor from ASU Law. Today, over 650 students graduate annually, receiving one of our five degrees: Juris Doctor (JD), Master of Laws (LLM), Master of Legal Studies (MLS), Master of Human Resources and Employment Law (MHREL), or Master of Sports Law and Business (MSLB). The law school has accomplished many significant milestones in its 50+ years. In 2006, the law school was renamed to honor **Justice Sandra Day O'Connor, the first woman appointed to the Supreme Court of the United States**. It is a privilege—and a great responsibility—to be entrusted with the late Justice O'Connor's name and legacy..

In 2016, ASU Law moved to the Beus Center for Law and Society building in the ASU downtown Phoenix campus, further enhancing the law school's service to the community and providing students access to the best legal opportunities. Students can also study beyond Phoenix at ASU locations in Los Angeles and Washington, D.C., as well as participate in global study abroad with externship or internship opportunities.

ASU Law's world-class faculty and administrators provide students with unparalleled opportunities to gain insights and practical skills needed to address legal challenges locally, nationally and globally. ASU Law also prides itself on its network of engaged alumni and its relationship to the broader legal community, which has fully embraced the law school and is dedicated to the success of its graduates. President. Phoenix Raceway

Latasha Causey is the President of NASCAR's Phoenix Raceway, overseeing the promotion and operation of the modernized facility that is a top motorsports and entertainment destination in the Phoenix market. She is the first African American female to hold this role in NASCAR's history. Causey is a Phoenix native who grew up in the West Valley. Prior to joining Phoenix Raceway, she was the Community Development Officer for Bell Bank. She worked with key business leaders and community organizations to guide Bell's efforts in helping minority-owned businesses, nonprofit organizations, underserved populations and neighborhoods. Causey is very active in the Phoenix community, being named 2023 Inspiring Sports Executive of the Year by Women in Sports and Entertainment (WISE), as one of the Most Influential Women in Arizona in 2021, and to the 2018 Outstanding Women in Business by Phoenix Business Journal. She has been a two-time KNOW Book feature, on the cover of 85085 magazine highlighting her volunteer work with the Girl Scouts, and highlighted in Front Doors magazine for her philanthropic work in the community. She is currently on the Valley of the Sun United Way and Boys and Girls Clubs of the Valley Boards of Directors.

As an educator and consultant, she leverages the intersection of her academic disciplines to create innovative and compelling learning experiences that inspire transformational change. Montz credits her Sandra Day O'Connor College of Law faculty with challenging her to develop agile and sophisticated models for critical thinking and to create meaningful connections across disciplines.

Convocation Address......John Shufeldt

Founder and board chair for Tribal Health and managing director for Xcellerant Ventures

John Shufeldt has over 30 years of expertise in guiding elite teams, pioneering healthcare solutions and fostering leadership. He obtained his Bachelor of Arts from Drake University in 1982 and later, his Medical Degree from the University of Health Sciences/The Chicago Medical School in 1986. He earned his MBA in 1995 and Juris Doctorate in 2005, both from Arizona State University. In 1993, Shufeldt established NextCare, Inc., which expanded under his guidance from one to 60 clinics across six states, generating nearly \$100 million in revenue. He also practices emergency medicine in various locations, including St. Joseph's Hospital. In 2010, after his tenure as NextCare's CEO, Shufeldt launched MeMD, LLC, connecting over 500 medical and mental health professionals to patients virtually. Walmart acquired

MeMD in 2021. Shufeldt's entrepreneurial spirit led him to create Tribal Health in 2015, addressing healthcare needs in Indigenous territories. The organization now employs over 470 experts across 51 Native American healthcare facilities. In 2021, he founded Xcellerant Ventures, a VC firm focused on nurturing budding health-tech startups.

Convocation Address......Vice Chief Justice Ann A. Scott Timmer

Arizona Supreme Court

Vice Chief Justice Ann A. Scott Timmer joined the Arizona Supreme Court in 2012. She was elected by her colleagues as Vice Chief Justice in 2019 and she will be sworn in as Chief Justice in July 2024. Justice Timmer is a member of the National Conference of Bar Examiners Board of Trustees, serves on the Board of Trustees of the Appellate Judges Education Institute and has been elected to The American Law Institute. She has been named one of a New Decade of Arizona's Most Intriguing Women (2022), an ABA Journal and ABA Center for Innovation Legal Rebel (2021) and the Arizona Capitol Times Woman of the Year (2020). Prior to being appointed to the Supreme Court bench, Justice Timmer served on the Arizona Court of Appeals for 12 years, serving as its chief judge for three years. Justice Timmer earned her bachelor's degree from the University of Arizona, her Juris Doctor, magna cum laude, from the Sandra Day O'Connor College of Law at Arizona State University and a Master of Judicial Studies from Duke University Law School.
